Halloween Facts

What is Halloween?

Halloween is a holiday celebrated annually on 31 October. It is the evening just before the two Christian holy days called the All Hallows' Day: All Saints' or Allhallowmas on 1 November.

All Souls' Day on 2 November.

Halloween is like a community based festival and is mostly celebrated in Western countries.

Kids and adults wear different costumes of their choice and attend costume parties.

Big pumpkins are carved into lanterns and put off for display by people in their houses.

Some people like to visit haunted houses or Halloween where they share scary stories with

each other. People also play pranks to one another.

Those who like to stay home watch horror movies.

Superstitious people light bonfires in their court yards to keep their house safe from ghosts and evil spirits.

Why is Halloween called Halloween?

In it is the evening before the All Hallows' Day, it was called All Hallows' Eve. Later on with time it changed into Halloween.

When is Halloween Day? When is Halloween celebrated?
